

**School District Goals and Objectives**

Prior to the start of each school year, the Board is responsible for setting goals and specific objectives to be accomplished by the District over that coming school year. The Board will develop these annual goals based on input solicited from a variety of sources and will strive to ensure that the resources necessary to accomplish the goals are available to the District. These goals will be shared with the community, the staff, and the students.

The administration shall develop appropriate objectives designed to achieve the stated goals and utilize reliable performance indicators to conduct fair and adequate assessments against meaningful standards to measure progress in achieving the goals and objectives.

The Board will regularly evaluate progress toward meeting the goals and will adopt appropriate policies designed to facilitate their accomplishment.

Prior to the close of each school year, the Superintendent will report to the Board on the state of the schools, the District's accomplishments in the pursuit of the set goals and objectives, and administrative recommendations for consideration and action. The report will provide the Board with information needed for making ongoing policy and planning decisions and for setting new goals and objectives for the following school year.
